

1 Plan your space

When planning your exhibition you need to consider the total length of wall area for display and the overall height.

We have designed the panels in three sizes to allow you to choose the best size option for your display area.

In addition we are also providing you with a 'blank' templated panel that will allow you to populate content and images in the exhibition style within a fixed grid. This can be used if wall space is limited and you need to use a limited number of panels or alternatively add additional panels.

2 Choose size

Option A - Small panels 700mm x 950mm

Option B - Medium panels 1100mm x 1500mm

Option C - Large panels 1400mm x 1900mm

3 Material specification


You will need to discuss size options with your local print company or exhibition manufacturer who will advise on the best method of printing and mounting.

As a guide, a suitable material for the substrate would be a 3mm DiBond (lightweight aluminium with pvc core). The prints are then mounted and edge wrapped with a final matt laminate for protection and cleaning.

Mounting is usually carried out using split battens or wall stud locators (please consult with your local supplier).
